The focus was on the Gospel of Luke 3:21-22 - The Baptism of Jesus.


We are created, called, and commissioned at our baptism, which fuels our joy to be beloved children of God.

Further along the shore, Jesus saw two brothers, James and John, fishing with their father. He called out the same invitation, and they left their father to follow Jesus. The phrase "to fish for people" is Jesus' invitation for us to truly follow him. This is a calling for everyone. When we accept this calling, we are invited to be disciples and to share this message with the world.
