

The Bible In Real Time Jesus Appears to Thomas John 20:24-29
This was such a rich discussion and the depth you possess and the willingness to listen beyond your own opinion makes it richer still.

From Ron -

We read the story of Jesus' appearance to the disciple Thomas in John's Gospel. We discussed some of the interesting details in the story, including the detail that the disciples were in a locked room and the fact that Thomas feels the wound in Jesus'

side. After talking about John's emphasis on the blessings of faith in this story, we turned to the idea that it can sometimes be spiritually dangerous to insist on seeing something. In the modern world we generally think "knowledge is power," so we don't generally regard seeing as potentially dangerous. But we talked about Saint Augustine's idea that there are "sins of the eye" that can harm our souls. Examples from his time included watching the gladiatorial games or risque theater performances. We talked about contemporary applications of this idea, especially in relation to the violent images associated with contemporary reporting from war zones.

Saturday, January 20. (All ages are welcome!):


