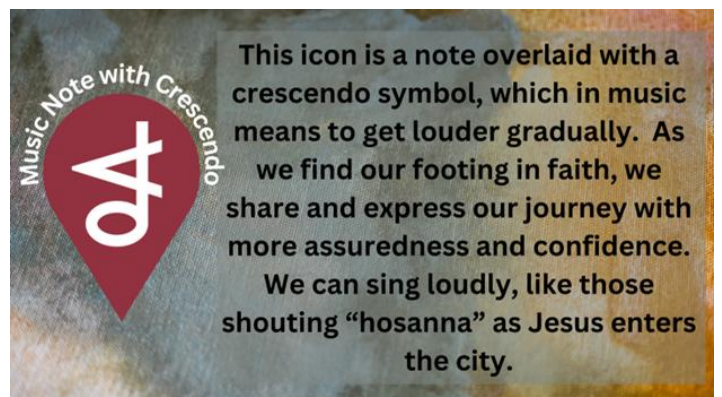

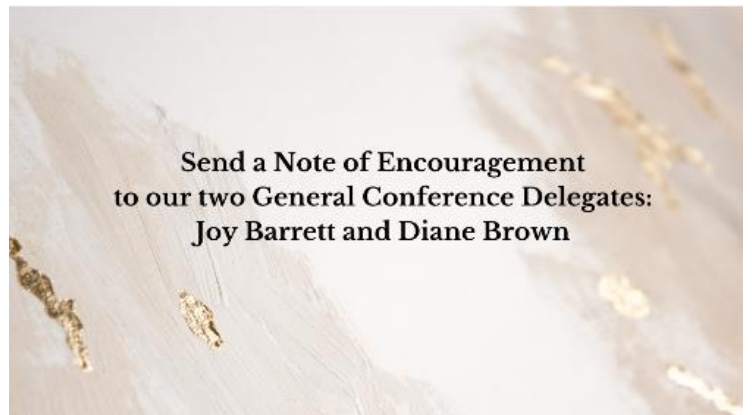
Palm Sunday means holding onto Christ's humility in John 12: 12-15, so that we can find our own love and power to share with the world. [Read More...](#)


