Faith Talk:

This week I invite you to reflect and wonder!

How many parts of the human body can you name? What jobs do they do? How are they different from each other? Are there any we don't need?

Which parts of the body can't you see? Do you know what they do?

Think about the different people in your family and the different personalities and gifts they bring even though they are one family unit.

What different things do Christians do to show they belong to Jesus and the Christian family? In church? At home? At work/ school? What could you do to show you are part of the Christian family? What gifts do you think that God has given you?

When Luli says the Mandarin Chinese word for tea, the other children respond with the word in their own language. Play recordings of the word 'tea' in other languages (check out <u>HERE</u>) and invite your child to repeat each one. Ask: *What are your favorite words for 'tea'? Why do you think so many languages have similar words for 'tea'?*


