Faith Talk:


This week, I offer you the devotional question of the day in the series - Everything in Between that is the focus of our Lenten Worship Series.


WHAT WE ARE WONDERING ABOUT

April Practice Theme: Everything in Between!

In April we will focus on the Series Everything (in) Between. This series, allows the Gospel of Luke to guide us through Lent. Many of these stories are well-known in both sacred and secular imagination, carrying cultural relevance and lore. Jesus intentionally highlights the cultural and political polarities of his time to emphasize the radical, inclusive, and surprising love of God. This Lent, we're trusting that God shows up in shades of gray, rainbow hues, and everywhere in between.

Last Sunday:

Last Sunday, we reflected on the Parable of the Lost Sheep based on Luke 15:1-7. Jesus was known for befriending those who had been left out or overlooked. The children and youth enacted the scripture during worship and we wonder some more about it during CONNECT.








This Sunday:


