
# Leadership Board sets dates for 2 more town halls

The Chelsea First Leadership Board set the dates for two additional town hall meetings as work continues on the transition to the new simplified accountable structure of church governance. Read More...






Dinner for Eight gatherings is a great way to help our church family get to know each other better. We have two more dinners - May and June. It is time to sign up for the May dinner. Read More...
