
# Family Spiritual Practice

## **April Practice Theme: Everything in Between!**

In April we will focus on the Series Everything (in) Between. This series, allows the Gospel of Luke to guide us through Lent. Many of these stories are well-known in both sacred and secular imagination, carrying cultural relevance and lore. Jesus intentionally highlights the cultural and political polarities of his time to emphasize the radical, inclusive, and surprising love of God. This Lent, we're trusting that God shows up in shades of gray, rainbow hues, and everywhere in between.

#### Last Sunday:

Last Sunday, we worshiped together in the Sanctuary. It was communion Sunday. The focus was on the story based on the Scripture of Luke 19:1-10. This story is about Jesus visiting a man named Zacchaeus who wanted to do what was right, but still ended up hurting his neighbors.

Jesus sees us. Jesus knows us. Jesus creates space. In Jesus, we have radical belonging.

This Sunday is **PALM SUNDAY, April 13**! We will be celebrating the start of Holy Week with a Palm parade at the 9 am service. Kids and youth (all are invited) will parade together through worship waving palm branches. The Palm Parade happens at the beginning of the service so please plan to arrive a little earlier this Sunday if at all possible.

This Sunday, we will focus on the Scripture reading of Luke 19:29-40 - Speaking up is as important as listening.

Palm Sunday marks the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, where crowds of people greeted him with shouts of "Hosanna!" and laid palm branches before him, celebrating his arrival as the long-awaited Messiah. Yet, this joyous occasion also sets the stage for the challenges and tensions that will unfold in the days ahead.

In the midst of the celebration, we are reminded that speaking up is just as crucial as listening. The crowds spoke out in praise, but not everyone in the city was prepared to listen to the message that Jesus brought—a message of love, justice, and humility. As followers of Christ, we are called to both speak out for what is right and listen deeply to God's voice, as well as to the voices of those around us.

Palm Sunday invites us to reflect on the importance of both expressing our truths and being open to hearing the truths of others. Just as the people of Jerusalem had a choice in how they responded to Jesus, we too have the choice to speak courageously for justice and peace while also listening attentively to the needs and voices of our communities. Both are necessary to build a world that reflects God's love and compassion.



In March, our children generously helped fill Easter goody bags for some of our congregation members. Now, the time has come to deliver these thoughtful gifts—and we need your help!


